 - b. Highlight 5 other critical costs you need to advice on successful poultry venture. (**5 Marks**)

Assume;

- i. Mortality of 10%
- ii. Broilers sold at 8 weeks old (all in, all out basis)
- iii. Layers kept for 78 weeks and started laying at 20 weeks
- iv. Broilers sold at 350/- per kg
- v. Eggs sold at 300/- per tray
- vi. Price of feeds; broiler starter @40/- /kg, broiler finisher @ 35/- kg, Chick and duck mash @40/ kg-, growers mash @ 40/- kg, layers mash @40/- per kg
- vii. Laying % = 80%
- viii. Price of culled birds = 400/- per bird
- 6. a. Assume you have been hired as an extension officer by county government to advance dairy cattle breeding. Explain traits you will advise the farmers to consider when selecting breeding stock..(15 Marks)
