

## **Orientation to E-Learning on Health Communication**

During the period under review, JOOUST in partnership with University of Nairobi and other Universities in Kenya mounted a short course on orientation to E-Learning on Health Communication. The training was mounted through University HIV Fellowship Training (UHIV) held in two Counties. The first training was held in Homabay County on April 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> 2016 where thirty (30) healthcare professionals were trained while the second training was held in Siaya County on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2016 during which thirty (30) healthcare professional were also trained.

The trainings equipped the trainees with skills of accessing course content through the virtual platform. The course content included effective health communication interventions for the benefit of disease control and prevention, environmental and occupational health, individual testing/counselling as well as public health. The workshop have trained health professionals from Siaya and Homabay Counties.
