Labor Demand

- b) Suppose the workers negotiate a benefit package that is worth \$1.50 to them, and costs the employer \$3.00 to provide. Calculate the new equilibrium wage rates, and quantity supplied. 4Marks
- c) How do your answers to part b. differ from your answers to part a. (if they do), and why? 2Marks
- d) Given the poverty levels in the country and the unstable financial support from development partners for the provision of health services in the country, explain at least four sources of funding that may be sustained in the long run to finance provision of health care 8Marks.
